“Preparing our best for the worst can help stabilize an otherwise intense situation”, this approach is embodied in You Will Not Stand Alone (YWNSA). Because of the sudden nature of these tragedies, training and preplanning are imperative. You Will Not Stand Alone provides guidelines to help you move through these events, ideas for pre-planning, suggestion for supporting the responders, and support mechanisms to ensure that no one will ever stand alone in the wake of such a tragedy.

Course Objectives: Maintaining morale and provide quicker healing from the “wound of a fatality” is imperative to a healthy workforce. This course will provide preparation ideas and guidance for Agency Administrators, employee, and all who could be called upon to offer assistance in the event of a critical incident. The focus is taking care of our own, pre-planning, agency and survivor support, knowing what to expect during the first 24 hours, knowing how to apply self-care and dealing with compassion fatigue.
