The intent of the Esperanza Staff Ride is to allow participants to examine and analyze fire ground decisions made by past leaders in concert with an on scene study of the actual terrain upon which the fire was fought. Staff Rides are effective tools that can be used to explore the strategic and operational lessons learned on a historical incident. Participants will learn lessons from the information references and subject matter experts to examine fire dynamics and human behavior within the wildland urban interface of Southern California.
