Pework for this session can be found at <http://onlinetraining.nwcg.gov/node/201>. **Bring the completed pre-course work with you to class for review.** You should also bring with you to class the NFES 0065 Fireline Handbook, Incident Response Pocket Guide, and five (5) copies of your local incident organizer.

Students should be familiar with and review the Redbook (Interagency Standards for Fire and Fire Aviation Operations) Chapter 11, Incident Management, pages 11-3 through 11-5 addressing Type 3 Incident Command and Characteristics.

The Fireline Handbook Chapter 3-Extended Attack, pages 109-118 should be reviewed, as this guidance will be applied in the classroom.

Each student shall bring with them their most recent IQCS printout showing their qualifications and training history.

Prerequisites as listed in the Field Manager's Course Guide, September, 2015, for the course are to be qualified as an incident commander type 4 (ICT4) and a task force leader (TFLD), or qualified as an ICT4 and as a strike team leader and any two single resource boss positions – one must be crew (CRWB) or engine (ENGB). Any student *not* meeting the prerequisite will be dismissed from the course.

Stay connected to the course you have been identified in, you may request that you be added to a mailing list that will email you. You will only receive one message per day (in the morning) and only if there was a change the day before for your session. Please note (although it isn't updated every day just when there is significant changes) when the Selection Roster is updated you will also get a message that there has been a change to your session.
