The following individuals have been selected to attend S-130 (Firefighter Training); S-190 (Introduction to Wildland Fire Behavior); ICS-100 (Introduction to ICS); IS-700 (Introduction to NIMS) and L-180 (Human Factors on the Fireline) known as Basic Firefighter Academy training, being conducted May 16 – 20, 2016 in partnership with and located at the College of Western Idaho (CWI) Nampa Campus Academic Building, 5500 E. Work Capacity Test Information (WCT): Basic Fire Academy will sponsor a live practice fire (Rx) on Thursday, May 19th, the minimum physical fitness level to participate in this exercise is the *Arduous* level. Most students will be completing the *Arduous* level to become qualified as a Firefighter Type 2 (FFT2). It is encouraged to have students complete the WCT prior to May 17th and provide supporting documentation from your home unit. However, on Tuesday May 17th at 0645 a WCT will be offered at the CWI Nampa Campus for students who have not completed and passed the WCT. **Students who would like to participate in this WCT must have documentation turned into their training officer / designated contact no later than Wednesday May 11th stating that they have been cleared for arduous duty and that they may participate in the WCT.** Please see the information below regarding the required documentation for each agency as each agency has different requirements in order to be cleared for arduous duty.



- Bureau of Land Management (BLM) participants are required to complete and be cleared for arduous duty prior to taking a pack test. There must be documentation provided to your training officer before taking the WCT. If students are not cleared for arduous duty before Monday May 17th, they will not be able to participate on the WCT being held on May 17th.
 - AD's under the BLM must complete a *Health Screen Questionnaire (HSQ)* in order to discover any potential health concerns. If there is an answer of Yes to any questions on the HSQ, then students will be required to complete a physical prior to taking the arduous WCT.

- Contractors will be cleared for duty via coordination with Grace Barnes of CWI (208) 562-2720 and will need to bring documentation that they have been cleared for duty on Monday May 16th

Equipment and Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Wednesday and Thursday will be field-going days and students must be dressed in the proper attire and have PPE. We realize not all students will come with the required protective clothing. On Tuesday, a form will be distributed and students will be given flame resistant clothing (nomex shirt and pants), linepack, gloves, goggles/safety glasses, and hardhat with chinstrap.

- Students must have Wildland Fire Boots that must meet the standard minimum 8-inch high, Vibram Soles, lace-type exterior leather work boots. We strongly encourage having boots broken-in and not brand new to avoid potential blisters.
- Monday, Tuesday, and Friday students will be taught in a classroom environment and may dress in attire appropriate for a classroom-led training.


- **Dining options near CWI Campus**

North of the Freeway




South of the Freeway
