

ADVANCED GROUP CRISIS INTERVENTION

APRIL 25—APRIL 27, 2017

The Danny Rhynes Interagency Training Center will be hosting an Advanced Critical Incident Stress Management (CISM) training **April 25-27, 2017** in San Bernardino, California. The Advanced Group Crisis Intervention builds on the knowledge base which was obtained through the Individual Crisis Intervention and Peer Support & Group Crisis Intervention course along with the experience obtained through serving as a Peer/Lead for CISM responses. Advanced defusings and debriefings in complex critical incident situations will be emphasized along with consequences of traumatic stress. Designed for law enforcement, fire, aviation, and agency personnel who will be trained to identify ways to support their peers who have experienced a critical incident.

Program highlights: Experiential group exercises to manage complex group oriented crisis interventions, such as crisis management briefings, multiple incidents CID, suicide of a colleague, small group crisis support sessions after a disaster in a comprehensive, integrated, systematic and multi-component CISM approach.

Instructor: Jack Harris, International Critical Incident Stress Foundation (ICISF Instructor)

Dates: Begins 0830 on Tuesday, April 25th and concludes 1700 on Thursday, April 27th

Tuition: \$400.00 per student and is the responsibility of the sending agency

Prerequisite: Individual Crisis Intervention and Peer Support & Group Crisis Intervention through an approved ICISF instructor
