- Team building
- Detecting operational error
- Managing stress

- Fireline Pack with the gear you would typically have on a fire assignment. You do not have to bring your hard hat nor your fire shelter.
- Dress for INCLIMENT weather. Chance of wet, cold, muddy conditions.
- Thursday is a field exercise. You will need a lunch, water, and appropriate clothing for the weather.
