#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

This 2-day workshop will review expectations, roles, and responsibilities for managing incidents that extend beyond Initial Attack and require a higher level of management due to incident complexity. This workshop is designed for anyone involved in Type 3 Incident Management. Participants will be provided information and tools to prepare them for interagency Type 3 assignments.

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

This year's workshop will focus on positive interagency working relationships, roles and responsibilities, team interaction, agency expectations, problem solving skills, and mentoring for new participants. Areas covered will include facilitated instruction for breakout sessions by position, interactions between sections, and scenario based exercises. Participants should leave ready to actively participate or support Type 3 Incidents. This seminar will serve as a refresher for qualified personnel and will assist in developing a training path for unqualified personnel.
