Course Information

This course is being offered through the National Outdoor Leadership School (NOLS) group and includes an additional class on cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR). This is an advanced first aid course that will incorporate wildfire and all-hazard scenarios.

The Wilderness First Aid (WFA) course will help you prepare for the unexpected with a fun, hands-on introduction to wilderness medical care.
